

Board of Education

Board Member Conflict of Interest

No Board of Education member shall have a beneficial interest directly or indirectly in any contract, work, or business of the District unless permitted by statute.

Board of Education members must annually file a "Statement of Economic Interests" as required by the Illinois Government Ethics Act. Each Board of Education member is responsible for filing the statement with the county clerk of the county in which the Board member resides by May 1.
