

Board of Education

Organizational Board of Education Meetings

The Board of Education shall organize within 7 days after a Board member election. At that meeting, the following will occur:

1. The Board of Education shall designate a president pro tempore. The duties of the president pro tempore will be to convene the organizational meeting, appoint a temporary secretary, and conduct the election of Board officers.
2. The Board of Education shall canvass the votes and declare the results of the election.
3. The new Board of Education members shall be immediately seated.
4. The Board of Education shall elect its officers who assume office immediately upon their election.
5. The Board of Education shall fix the times and places for its regular meetings. The Superintendent shall have the responsibility of preparing and making available the calendar of regular Board of Education meetings in accordance with The School Code.
6. The Board shall appoint, reappoint, or affirm the continuing appointments of its Legal Counsel, Architects, and Auditors of record.
