### **Board Legislative Program**

The Board of Education will initiate and maintain an active legislative program designed to:

1. promote the passage of new laws which advance excellence in education;
2. promote the repeal or modification of existing laws which impede excellence in education.

The Board's legislative program may include, but not be limited to, the following activities:

1. The Board will maintain an active interest in legislative activities through designated representatives to conferences with the state and national school boards associations.
2. The Board may direct the Superintendent and the Board's representatives to work for the achievement of common legislative objectives through these associations and with other concerned groups.
3. The Board will also maintain, through the administration and designated representatives, both direct and indirect efforts to achieve the Board's positions on pending legislation with appropriate state and federal legislators and legislative committees.
