## **Recognitions & Achievements:**

Dr. Drury recognized the Wheaton Warrenville South High School's Boys Volleyball Team who won their third consecutive State Volleyball Championship last weekend. This is a tremendous accomplishment and we hope to introduce the team members to the Board at the July meeting.

## **The Board took the following action:**

Approved to post the Title I Mathematics curriculum, grades K-5, and the PACE (Gifted) Mathematics curriculum, grades 3-5, for public review for 30 days.

Approved to post for 30-day public review and comment the following District policies:

- 5.30 General Personnel, Hiring Process and Criteria
- 4.150 Facility Management and Expansion Programs

Approved to continue for the 2009-10 school year the intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Wheaton for one senior liaison patrol officer at each high school. The District pays 75% of the cost of the two officers.

Awarded a one-year contract extension with Triple 'S' Vending to provide snack vending at both high schools.

Approved a one-year extension of the food service contract with Sodexo.

Approved a one-year extension of the custodial services contract with GCA Services Group, Inc.

The Board received a report on the reorganization of the District's English Language Learner Program that will be in place for the 2009-10 school year.
