Approval of Student Discipline

MOTION

Should the student fail to attend or successfully complete the alternative educational program, the expulsion will be immediately enacted for the remainder of the expulsion term without further action by the Board of Education. Upon a roll call being taken, the vote was: AYE 5, NAY 0. **The motion carried 5-0.**
