AP Resources, Join Codes, and College Board Accounts

Welcome to your AP class! You will need to join each AP class you are in using a Join Code provided to you by your teacher. You will be able to access online resources for each AP class. There is a unique join code for each section. Please join asap to have resources available to you. Also, during the AP exam registration period in October (more info later!) you will need to indicate yes/no to taking the exam. Already being logged into your class will make this an easier process.

START NOW!! Please join as soon as your teacher gives you the Join Code.

COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT: Existing Some of you already have a College Board Account since you took a PSAT and/or SAT in the past. You need to log into that account as that is your College Board account going forward every year. This is also where you will access the new AP resources and sign up to take the exam this year. You will no longer get a new AP number each year. We, in the CC, do **NOT** have account info. Many parents have been known to make the account for you as they were anxious to see your past test results. Make sure you check with them. JOIN UP Once you have your College Board account ready, log into [myAP](#) to join your class. Create an account once, but use the separate join code for each class if you are taking more than one AP course.
