## Monroe Middle School - School Procedures

### ATTENDANCE /EARLY DISMIS-SAL OR LATE ARRIVAL:

If your student is absent, please call the attendance office 630-682-2290 **before** 8:00 a.m. to report the absence. When a student needs to be dismissed early from school for a doctor's appointment, orthodontist appointment, etc., please call the attendance office before 8:00 a.m., at 630-682-2290. The student will then receive a pass to give to his/her teacher indicating the appropriate dismissal time. All students must sign themselves in and out in the main office before leaving the building.

#### **VISITORS:**

Any visitors to the school **must** sign in and show ID at the main office.

#### **IMPORTANT ASBESTOS NOTICE:**

Monroe Middle School contains some asbestos containing building materials. These materials are inspected and maintained under a management plan as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). A copy of the management plans is available at the school for inspection.

#### **CELL PHONE PROCEDURE:**

Appropriate use of cell phones:

Permitted Before School until the 7:55 AM Bell, then off and away for the remainder of the day.

Teachers may allow cell phones during class for instructional purpose.

After school, at 3:00 PM, cell phones will be permitted.

After school activities, cell phone use must be approved by the supervisor.

Inappropriate use of cell phones: If your phone is out and being used without permission

The teacher will provide a warning and will call your parents.

Office referral, Mrs. Thomas or Mr. Crespo will call your parent.


Detention and/or parent required to pick up the phone from school may occur.

#### **FORGOTTEN ITEMS:**

Forgotten lunches can be placed in the appropriate grade level bins and larger items on the "forgotten items" table located in the main vestibule.

#### **VACATIONS:**

Vacations during the school year are discouraged. Even the most conscientious efforts of students and teachers are no substitute for daily attendance. If students must take a vacation during the school year, they need to notify the office at least one week prior to the absence. They should plan to do work before leaving or during the vacation. Students should arrange to come in before or after school to make up tests or lab work.



#### **FROM THE MONROE HEALTH OFFICE:**

Welcome back to the 2022-2023 school year. The school building is now open. This is a reminder from Health Services that health requirements of a physical and immunizations for incoming 6th grade students are due by the first day of school. Please drop off the paperwork any time during our office hours. A list of the health requirements and the forms can be found on both the district and school websites under the "Health Services" heading. 6th grade students will also need documentation of a dental exam. Exclusion day is the day after Labor Day (Tuesday, September 6th). If we don't have the physical and required immunizations by that date, your child will be excluded from school until we receive the required paperwork. Please call the health office or email monroehealthoffice@cusd200.org if you need some resources or have any questions. Thank you and we look forward to having your new student as a Monroe Eagle!

## **Fall Sports Information**

#### **Girls Volleyball Tryout Information:**

7th & 8th Grade Girls Volleyball Tryouts:

- Wednesday, August 24th, Thursday, August 25th and Friday, August 26th.
- -7th Grade: 3-4:30pm and 8th Grade: 4:30-6pm
- All 7th/8th graders must have a sports physical on file with Mr. McCormack in order to try out. This can be dropped off at the Monroe front office before school begins (please write your athlete's name and "To Mr. McCormack" on a sealed envelope). It can also be turned in in-person at the first day of tryouts to the volleyball coaches or Mr. McCormack.
- Sports physicals are good for 13 months until they expire. The date of the examination needs to be showing on the form.
- There is a \$125 fee to participate unless your child is on free or reduced lunch. Then there is a lesser fee

#### **Cross Country:**

6-8 Grade Cross Country - Informational Meeting

- Tuesday, August 23rd from 3-4pm
- First day of practice: Wednesday, August 24, 3:00-4:00
- -6th graders do not need a <u>sports physical to start practice (their 6th grade school physical replaces it).</u>
- -7th & 8th graders must have a sports physical on file with Mr. McCormack in order to participate. This can be dropped off at the Monroe front office before school begins (please write your athlete's name and "To Mr. McCormack" on a sealed envelope). It can also be turned in in-person at the first day of practice to the XC coaches or Mr. McCormack.
- -7th & 8th Graders without a current sports physical will not be able to start practice! Sports physicals are good for 13 months until they expire. The date of the examination needs to be showing on the form.
