<b><i>Advanced Placement Summer Bridge Program</i></b>		
<p>The AP Summer Bridge Program allows students the opportunity to prepare for Advanced Placement, college level coursework. Students take an AP Summer Bridge course to build skills and content knowledge prior to the beginning of the academic year. These courses are an excellent opportunity for students to prepare themselves for an AP course.</p>
