College Credit	<p style="text-align: center;">NOT GUARANTEED</p> <p>Earning college credit depends on how well students perform on an exam. All public institutions of higher education in Illinois will award college credit for a score of 3 or higher on the exam. The receiving institution typically makes the final decision on the acceptability of AP Exam scores and how much credit will be awarded if any, so it is best to check with each individual institution.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">GUARANTEED</p> <p>Upon successful completion of the year-long course students receive 6 credit hours from Loyola University on an official Loyola University transcript that can transfer to other colleges and universities. These credits are generally transferable to other accredited colleges and universities across the nation. However, the receiving institution will always make the final decision on the transferability of courses.</p>
Cost Savings	Potential to save tuition costs if a student performs well on their AP exam.	\$65/credit hour versus the regular Loyola University rate of \$788/credit hour.

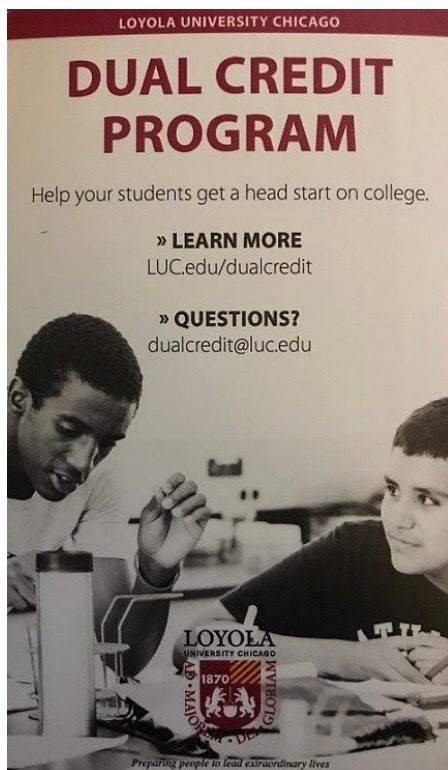

Monday, September 21	Last day to <b>apply</b> to Loyola's Dual Credit Program
Wednesday, October 14	Last day to <b>register</b> for Dual Credit Classes
Monday, November 2	Last day to <b>drop</b> a semester-long course with no penalty – tuition refunded.  After this date, students enrolled in a semester-long course will have their earned grade posted to their transcript. No tuition refunded.
Monday, November 2	Dual Credit first-semester tuition due
Friday, December 4	Students dropped for non-payment
<b>Spring 2021</b>	
Monday, February 22	Last day to <b>register</b> for second-semester courses
Friday, March 12	Last day to <b>drop</b> new second semester courses with no penalty. Tuition refunded.  After this date, students enrolled in a semester-long course will have their earned grade posted to their transcript. No tuition refunded.
Monday, March 15	Dual Credit second-semester tuition due
Monday, April 5	Students dropped from second-semester courses for non-payment
