District 200 is following the guidance and expectations established by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Illinois Department of Public Health. District 200 Health Services staff monitor the health and wellness of all our students. We continue to be proactive in our cleaning practices.

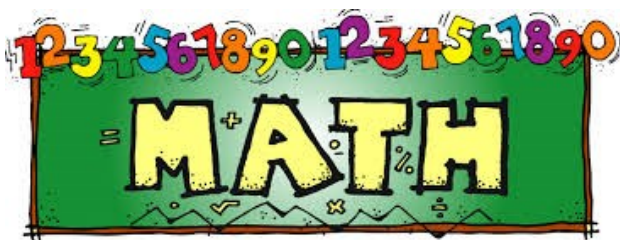
Staff members are reminded to promote universal precautions among students, including frequent hand washing. In addition, we will monitor all travel for any school activities that may be affected.

All Emerson students have received instruction from the school nurse on infection control, including covering your cough, sneeze, and hand washing. Classroom teachers are continuing to communicate these protocols with their students.

There is currently no vaccine to prevent COVID-19. The CDC recommends the following preventative actions:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if your hands are visibly dirty.
