For right now they will be filling out an interest sheet or putting in holds using [Destiny Discover \(Video Directions\)](#) and books will be delivered to their classroom. They will also return their books in their classroom.



Circulation policies and due dates may shift throughout the year, and I will try to communicate those clearly. For right now books can be kept for up to 3 weeks, and we will attempt to get new books to K-1 weekly, and 2-5 as they are requested. Please help remind your child to be responsible for the library books they bring home. However, accidents happen, pages rip or start to fall out. Please do not attempt to repair a book at home. We have special supplies that allow the books to last longer. A fine will only be charged if the book is lost or needs to be completely replaced.

The most important thing is to help encourage your child to read their library books at home! Learning to read for a young child is a thrilling experience. You can foster this attitude by reading to your child, with your child, or reading your own book while your child reads. This is a memorable experience for both parents and children.
