

SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

If a student meets the criteria to receive special education and related services, an Individualized Education Program (IEP) is developed. An IEP is a written statement of the educational program designed to meet the student's needs and is developed by a multidisciplinary team. The IEP includes a description of the special education supports and accommodations, supplementary aids and services, and coursework the student will receive. The IEP will be reviewed and revised, based on the student's needs, at least once per year, as required by the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA).
