November 1: A common early action deadline for college applications.

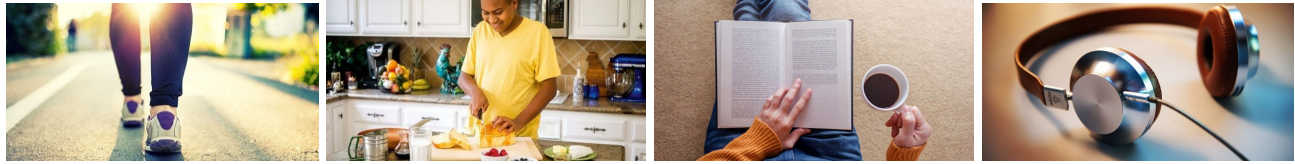
Seniors, be sure to keep on top of deadlines for college applications. Remember to request any official transcripts you may need at least 10 days in advance of your deadline.
