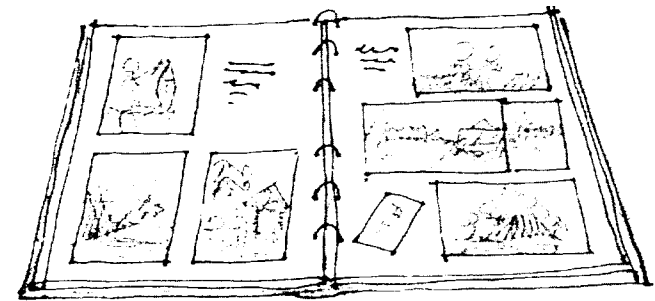


## Activity

# Making a picture book

- Cut cardboard into same sized pieces.
- Put three holes in the pieces on the left side.
- Tie the pieces together with yarn, so you will have a book.
- Put a picture of someone or something your child likes on each page (family, pets and Teddy Bear).
- Talk about what your child sees.
- Have your child take the book to school and share with the teacher.

# Making a picture book



To help your child succeed, you can:

- Make the pictures bigger.
- Turn the pages for your child.
- Let your child touch the pictures.
- Name who is in each picture.
- Show your child the book when he/she is in a quiet mood.

To make this activity more challenging, you can:

- Have more persons in the pictures.
- Have your child name who is in each picture.
- Talk about what your child does with each picture.
- Have the people's names written under their pictures.
