Many ways to write

Your child can write words with:

- Crayons, pens, and pencils.
- Finger paint.
- Letters cut out of magazines or food packaging.
- Letter on blocks.
- Letter stickers.
- Magnetic letters.
- Wooden or foam letters, or letters made with play dough.



Hints



Many ways to write



To help your child succeed, you can:

- Play with the letters while doing something your child enjoys (bath, singing, sitting on your lap).
- Begin with only a few letters (letters in your child's name).
- Say the letter names when your child touches them.
- Write your child's name.

To make this activity more challenging, you can:

- Have your child say the name and sound of the letters.
- Talk about how your child can make words with the letters.
- Have your child write his/her name.
- Take a product with a big label and ask your child to copy its name.
