

# WHEATON NORTH 2019 SUMMER SCHOOL DRIVER EDUCATION

Session I: June 10<sup>th</sup> – July 5<sup>th</sup>

Session II: July 8<sup>th</sup> – August 2<sup>nd</sup>

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a two-phase correlated program which fulfills the state requirements for obtaining a driver's license before a student's eighteenth birthday. The classroom phase emphasizes the theory of good driving practice and safety precautions. Stress will be on the development of good attitudes toward driving safely. The behind-the-wheel phase permits the practice and perfection, as much as possible, in the art of driving a vehicle. **The student will become eligible for a drivers license when they have completed the course requirements, had their permit for a minimum of nine months, and have turned sixteen.**

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Prerequisite: Student must be fifteen (15) years old by the first day of the session.**

Two sections of Driver Education are offered each session at Wheaton North High School. This two-phase program requires daily attendance for classroom **from 11:30 to 1:30 (Session I) or 10:30 – 12:30 (Session II) (for the first 3 weeks)**. The Behind-the-Wheel phase of the program will require the student to get **12 one-hour lessons with their certified instructor on a daily and/or every other day basis**. Their one-hour lesson will either be before the classroom start or after classroom dismissal. Here are the times they can choose from:

7:30 – 8:30    8:30 – 9:30    9:30 – 10:30    10:30 – 11:30 (**Session I only**)    12:30 – 1:30 (**Session II only**)    1:30 – 2:30

**Students must be available from 10:30 am to 12:30 p.m. daily during the first three weeks and their one hour driving lesson.** Students will receive a four-week schedule prior to the first day of class. **Students are allowed no more than two classroom absences during the four-week session and all behind-the-wheel sessions must be attended.** Students are encouraged to continue with their other extracurricular activities during the summer (i.e. sports camps....). They must speak with their coaches/sponsors if they are going to be absent from one of their other activities outside of Driver Education. **\*\*\*\*REMINDER:** Athletes should be aware of their summer camp(s) dates before registering for summer Driver Education. ## STATE DRIVER ED REQUIREMENT:

A student must have passed a minimum of eight (8) courses in the two previous school semesters in order to enroll in Summer Driver Ed and must be at least 15 by day one of their session. It is the student's responsibility to provide an official copy of the two previous semester's grades if these are not available at WNHS. \* It is **mandatory** that the student informs their counselor during next-year course selection that they are hoping to enroll in summer Driver Education. A separate registration form is required.

## REGISTRATION

**DATES:** During next-year Course Selection with assigned counselor (Due **February 28<sup>th</sup>**- Counseling Office) **A separate registration sheet can be obtained by the counseling secretary or individual counselors.** **Enrollment is based on birth date, NOT on a first come, first served basis.**

**COST:** \$250.00 fee must be paid at time of registration unless approved for a fee waiver through the district. Check should be made payable to **CUSD 200**. Please put student ID# on the check. Checks will not be cashed until enrollment is finalized.

\*Any student who does not attend a District 200 school, but lives in District 200 must furnish, at the time of registration, an official transcript from his/her current school showing at least two previous semesters of grades from his/her current school. Also two documents verifying residency are required at that time. **Wheaton North students are given priority of spots.**

## IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>** (7:00 pm): **Mandatory Parent/Student Meeting & Permit Test/Registration – WN Commons**  
\*At least one parent and the student enrolled in Driver Education must attend. The permit and vision tests and online registration will be done by students at this time. Please bring a check or money order (NOT CASH) in the amount of **\$20.00** payable to **The Secretary of State**. This is the fee for the driver permit and is needed by **ALL participants, fee waiver or not.**
- **Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup>** (2:20 pm): **Mandatory Student Meeting**  
\*Students will receive their permits and go over the summer schedule. Behind-the-wheel times and groups will be finalized at this time.
