

Important Required Testing Dates - April 2020

Each Spring, our students participate in several tests required by the Illinois State Board of Education; students are automatically registered for these required tests. We're asking for your partnership in making sure your student is at school on these dates. Students who miss the required state testing will be scheduled to participate in make-up testing. If at all possible and to avoid loss of class time for make-up testing, we ask that students attend on the originally scheduled test dates. There is no specific preparation students need to do in advance of the tests.

Scheduled Test Dates by Grade Level

Freshmen - Tuesday, April 14, 2020 - PSAT 8/9

Sophomores - Tuesday, April 14, 2020 - PSAT 10

Juniors, Tuesday, April 14, 2020 - SAT* AND Tues., April 21 - IL Science Assessment

Seniors -Tuesday, April 14, 2020 is a non-attendance day for Seniors.

*The Junior SAT is a college-reportable score which can be used in the college application process.

Optional Support: If students would like extra practice to enhance their scores, there are free resources available online. Students can link their scores from the PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10 and SAT to Khan Academy, which provides an online personalized study plan and coordinated online study materials - all for FREE.
