While VA is something that is new to us all, we wanted to share with you the items we think students will need at home in order to prepare for a successful start to the year. We also understand that each family is unique, and the list of "Suggested Items for All Grades" below represents items that you'll want to consider when setting up your at home learning space. Some of these suggested things are items we have in regular classrooms that you may want to have at home, too, such as a stapler or hole puncher. There are also some items on the grade level supply lists that will be used for art.

A few tips to consider:

- Reuse old supplies from previous years; there's no need to buy new if you have something at home already!
- The brands or types of supplies does not matter; use what works for your budget and family.
- Consider using items, such as dice, from a game you already have at home.
- Your child's teacher may ask for additional supplies that are unique to their own classroom.
- Find a quiet space in your home for your child to work each day; have an organization system that works for you and your child.
- Please replenish supplies as needed throughout the year.

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## Elementary Virtual Academy Supply List 2020-2021

*All Virtual Academy students will be provided with a D200 issued Chromebook.*

### **Suggested Items for All Grades:**

- A computer mouse for the Chromebook
- Supply box/pencil pouch and/or backpack to keep all school supplies and materials organized
- Gym shoes for virtual PE
- Pencil sharpener
- Scratch paper, such as loose leaf paper or a ream of white copy paper
- Post-It notes (these can be used for a variety of things, such as bookmarks or a way to organize yourself)
- Clipboard
- Index cards
- Ziplock baggies for organizing flashcards
- Access to a hole puncher, 3-hole puncher, or stapler for organizing binders/folders

### **Art Supplies Suggested for All Grades:**

- Any kind of additional coloring supplies already available around the house (crayons, colored pencils, marker, paint, oil pastels, chalk, or any other item that deposits color)
- Paper (Examples: backs of mailers, scratch paper, copy paper, cardstock, or a blank notebook)
- Recyclables as needed (cardboard boxes, catalogs, etc.)
- Additional tools for drawing that you already have around the house (ballpoint pen, flair pen, sharpie, or gel pens)

- Earbuds or headphones, preferably with a built-in microphone (headphones are recommended for kindergarten)
- Multicolor pack of construction paper
- Math manipulatives:
  - Small items that can be used for counting, such as cotton balls, beads, beans, etc.
  - 2 dice
  - Deck of cards
  - Ruler (inch and metric)
