- Project must be in a **pocket folder – do not use plastic sleeves**
- Cover Page (does not need to be on the cover of the pocket folder)
- Graph of Laps
- Short Answer sheet and this paper
- Illinois Road Map

### Cover Page

Your cover page should include an illustration and the name of your final destination.  
IN the **bottom right hand corner** you need your name, your teacher's name, class period.

**Page 1** Graph the laps you ran each week. Your graph should have a title, your X-axis should reflect "Time" and your Y-axis should be reflect "Laps Completed". Include on this page the following: your goal, how many laps you ran and the % of your goal you finished each week.

**Page 2** The Short Answer sheet

**Page 3** (the back page) this paper-the rubric

### In the folder pocket

#### Road Map

Each lap you run in class = 10 miles. You will plan a route on your map that will take you from Wheaton to your final destination using all of the miles that you ran in class. Your route must be on the roads and within the state of Illinois. Roads should only be used once. At the end of your running, highlight the route you traveled. Example: If you ran 45 laps, you would highlight 450 road miles on the map-starting in Wheaton and ending in your city. If you run short of your goal, you highlight only what you ran. If you run more, highlight beyond your city number of extra laps in road miles. Light yellow highlighters don't work well on the maps.
